

COMMISSION REGULATION (EEC) No 685/79**of 5 April 1979****amending Regulation (EEC) No 3083/73 on the communication of the information necessary for implementing Regulation (EEC) No 2358/71 on the common organization of the market in seeds**

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 2358/71 of 26 October 1971 on the common organization of the market in seeds⁽¹⁾, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 234/79⁽²⁾, and in particular Article 9 thereof,

Whereas experience has shown that certain of the information required under Commission Regulation (EEC) No 3083/73⁽³⁾, and the dates fixed therein for its communication were out of line with the reality of the market in seeds; whereas, therefore, the relevant

provisions should be adjusted; whereas that Regulation should also cover the information to be supplied in connection with the registration of contracts under Commission Regulation (EEC) No 2514/78⁽⁴⁾;

Whereas the measures provided for in this Regulation are in accordance with the opinion of the Management Committee for Seeds,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Sole Article

The Annex to Regulation (EEC) No 3083/73 is replaced by the Annex to this Regulation.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.

⁽⁶⁾ Imports from third countries shall be broken down by country of origin and imports from Member States shall be broken down by Member State of consignment.

The particulars to be communicated shall indicate for each item:

- quantities and free-at-frontier prices/100 kg.
