

**COUNCIL REGULATION (EEC) No 1551/79**

of 24 July 1979

**fixing, for the 1979/80 marketing year, the list of Community regions which qualify for aid in respect of durum wheat and fixing the amount of such aid**

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 2727/75 of 29 October 1975 on the common organization of the market in cereals<sup>(1)</sup>, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 1547/79<sup>(2)</sup>, and in particular Article 10 (2) thereof,

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission,

Having regard to the opinion of the European Parliament<sup>(3)</sup>,Having regard to the opinion of the Economic and Social Committee<sup>(4)</sup>,

Whereas, while providing for the maintenance of durum wheat production at its present level, the production thereof should be encouraged only in areas

with a low yield in order to maintain the level of producers' incomes in those areas,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION :

*Article 1*

For the 1979/80 marketing year, the aid for durum wheat provided for in Article 10 of Regulation (EEC) No 2727/75 shall be granted in the Community regions listed in the Annex hereto. Such aid shall be 77.31 ECU per hectare.

*Article 2*Regulation (EEC) No 1259/78<sup>(5)</sup> is hereby repealed.*Article 3*

This Regulation shall enter into force on 1 August 1979.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
