COMMISSION REGULATION (EEC) No 2054/79

of 20 September 1979

fixing the quantities of frozen beef and veal intended for processing which may be imported on special conditions for the fourth quarter of 1979

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES.

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 805/68 of 27 June 1968 on the common organization of the market in beef and veal (1), as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 425/77 (2), and in particular Article 14 (4) (a) and (c) thereof,

Whereas the Council, under the special import arrangements applicable to frozen beef and veal intended for processing, established for the period 1 January to 31 December 1979 an estimate of 60 000 tonnes, divided into two equal quantities of 30 000 tonnes each, according to the nature of the products to be obtained;

Whereas, pursuant to Article 14 (4) (a) of Regulation (EEC) No 805/68, it is necessary to determine the quantities to be imported every quarter as well as the rate of reduction of the import levy on the meat referred to in Article 14 (1) (b) of the said Regulation; whereas for the fourth quarter of 1979 these quantities represent the remainder of the quantities stated in the estimate referred to above;

Whereas the measures provided for in this Regulation are in accordance with the opinion of the Management Committee for Beef and Veal,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

For the period 1 October to 31 December 1979 the maximum quantities referred to in Article 14 (4) (a) of Regulation (EEC) No 805/68 shall be fixed:

- at 7 270 tonnes of meat, expressed in bone-in meat for meat referred to in Article 14 (1) (a) of Regulation (EEC) No 805/68,
- at 7 877 tonnes of meat, expressed in bone-in meat for meat referred to in Article 14 (1) (b) of the said Regulation.

Article 2

The import levy on the meat referred to in the second indent of Article 1 shall be equal to the levy applicable on the day of import reduced by 45 %.

Article 3

This Regulation shall enter into force on 1 October 1979.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
