

COMMISSION REGULATION (EEC) No 2153/79

of 2 October 1979

amending for the second time Regulation (EEC) No 918/79 opening a standing invitation to tender for the putting-up for sale of olive oil held by the Italian intervention agency

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation No 136/66/EEC of 22 September 1966 on the establishment of a common organization of the market in oils and fats⁽¹⁾, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 590/79⁽²⁾, and in particular Article 12 (4) thereof,

Whereas Regulation (EEC) No 918/79⁽³⁾, as amended by Regulation (EEC) No 1601/79⁽⁴⁾, provided for the sale of approximately 55 600 tonnes of olive oil of various qualities held by the Italian intervention agency;

Whereas the market situation and market prospects for olive oil in Italy are favourable at the moment for continuing the sale of the oil in question; whereas it

is appropriate therefore to make provision for this oil to be sold also during October 1979;

Whereas the measures provided for in this Regulation are in accordance with the opinion of the Management Committee for oils and fats,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

The following date is added to Article 3 (2) of Regulation (EEC) No 918/79:

‘— 8 October 1979’.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on the day following its publication in the *Official Journal of the European Communities*.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
