

COUNCIL REGULATION (EEC) No 2130/80
of 5 August 1980
amending Regulation (EEC) No 950/68 on the Common Customs Tariff

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN
COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European
Economic Community, and in particular Article 113
thereof,

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission,

Whereas, following safeguard measures taken by the
Community in the synthetic fibres sector, consulta-
tions under GATT have taken place with the United
States of America ;

Whereas these consultations have led to a mutually
satisfactory solution consisting, for the Community, of
the accelerated introduction, for certain products, of

concessions resulting from the 1979 Geneva Protocol
annexed to the General Agreement on tariffs and
trade,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION :

Article 1

The conventional rates of duty of the Common
Customs Tariff relating to products listed in the
Annex hereto are fixed as shown in the said Annex.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on 1 September
1980.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member
States.
