

COMMISSION REGULATION (EEC) No 2222/81

of 31 July 1981

amending for the second time Regulation (EEC) No 55/81 authorizing the Hellenic Republic to suspend the customs duties applicable on import of certain oil seeds and oleaginous fruits

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

Having regard to the Act of Accession of Greece, and in particular Article 64 (4) thereof,

Whereas, for certain oils falling within subheading 15.07 D II of the Common Customs Tariff, the basic duties are fixed in Article 64 (3) of the Act of Accession ; whereas this very high level is liable to prove an obstacle to the supply of raw materials for oiling dried grapes ; whereas these oils are put to special uses and the customs duties on imports of these products

should therefore be altered and Commission Regulation (EEC) No 55/81 ⁽¹⁾, as amended by Regulation (EEC) No 1527/81 ⁽²⁾, amended in consequence ;

Whereas the measures provided for in this Regulation are in accordance with the opinion of the Management Committee for Oils and Fats,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION :

Article 1

In the Annex to Regulation (EEC) No 55/81 the entry relating to heading No 15.07 of the Common Customs Tariff is hereby replaced by the following :

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on the third day following its publication in the *Official Journal of the European Communities*.

It shall apply with effect from 1 January 1981.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
