COMMISSION REGULATION (EEC) No 2906/82

of 29 October 1982

fixing the rate of the aid for peas and field beans used in the feeding of animals

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 1431/82 of 18 May 1982 laying down special measures for peas and field beans (1), and in particular Article 3 (6) thereof,

Whereas the amount of the aid referred to in Article 3 of Regulation (EEC) No 1431/82 was fixed by Regulation (EEC) No 2140/82 (2), as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 2628/82 (3);

Whereas it follows from applying the rules and other provisions contained in Regulation (EEC) No 2140/82 and in Article 105 of the Act of Accession of Greece to the information at present available to the Commission that the amount of the subsidy at present in force should be altered as shown in Article 1 of this Regulation,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

The aid referred to in Article 3 of Regulation (EEC) No 1431/82 is fixed at 11.935 ECU per 100 kilograms for peas and field beans used in the feeding of animals, processed in the Member States other than Greece where the price for the same products processed therein is fixed at 11.556 ECU per 100 kilograms.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on 1 November 1982.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
