

COMMISSION REGULATION (EEC) No 2867/84
of 11 October 1984
amending Regulation (EEC) No 2213/76 on the sale of skimmed-milk powder
from public storage

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN
COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European
Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 804/68
of 27 June 1968 on the common organization of the
market in milk and milk products ⁽¹⁾, as last amended
by Regulation (EEC) No 1557/84 ⁽²⁾, and in particular
Article 7 (5) thereof,

Whereas Article 1 of Commission Regulation (EEC)
No 2213/76 ⁽³⁾, as last amended by Regulation (EEC)
No 2538/84 ⁽⁴⁾, provides that intervention agencies
shall sell to any person wishing to purchase
skimmed-milk powder placed in storage with them
before 1 January 1984; whereas the situation on the
market for skimmed-milk powder is at present one of
shortage; whereas vitaminized skimmed-milk powder
intended for use as food aid must be as fresh as
possible; whereas it should therefore be stipulated that
the limit referred to in Article 1 of Regulation (EEC)
No 2213/76 does not apply to sales of skimmed-milk
powder intended for use as food aid in the framework

of the programmes decided by the national authori-
ties;

Whereas the measures provided for in this Regulation
are in accordance with the opinion of the Management
Committee for Milk and Milk Products,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

The following sentence is hereby added to Article 1 of
Regulation (EEC) No 2213/76:

‘The latter condition shall not apply to sales of
skimmed-milk powder intended for use as food aid
in the framework of programmes decided or recog-
nized by the national authorities.’

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on the day
following its publication in the *Official Journal of the
European Communities*.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member
States.
