

COMMISSION REGULATION (EEC) No 1635/85**of 17 June 1985****amending Regulation (EEC) No 2041/75 on special detailed rules for the application of the system of import and export licences and advance fixing certificates for oils and fats**

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN
COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European
Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation No 136/66/EEC
of 22 September 1966 on the establishment of a
common organization of the market in oils and fats ⁽¹⁾,
as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 231/85 ⁽²⁾,
and in particular Article 28 (3) thereof,

Whereas Article 6 (3) of Commission Regulation
(EEC) No 2041/75 ⁽³⁾, as last amended by Regulation
(EEC) No 710/81 ⁽⁴⁾, lays down the period for which
export licences containing an advance fixing of the
refund are valid ; whereas, with a view to harmonizing
with similar provisions in other sectors and in the
light of past experience, a longer period of validity
should be introduced than that currently applicable ;

Whereas the measures provided for in this Regulation
are in accordance with the opinion of the Management
Committee for Oils and Fats,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION :

Article 1

Article 6 (3) of Regulation (EEC) No 2041/75 is hereby
replaced by the following :

'3. An export licence where the refund is fixed
in advance shall be valid from its actual day of
issue until the end of the fourth month following
that of issue.'

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on the day of its
publication in the *Official Journal of the European
Communities*.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member
States.
