

**COMMISSION REGULATION (EEC) No 1074/89**

of 26 April 1989

**repealing Regulations (EEC) No 2471/88 and (EEC) No 2751/88 relating to invitations to tender for export refunds on cereals**

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,  
Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 2727/75 of 29 October 1975 on the common organization of the market in cereals<sup>(1)</sup>, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 166/89<sup>(2)</sup>,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 2746/75 of 29 October 1975 laying down general rules for granting export refunds on cereals and criteria for fixing the amount of such refunds<sup>(3)</sup>, and in particular Article 5 thereof,

Whereas Commission Regulations (EEC) No 2471/88<sup>(4)</sup> and (EEC) No 2751/88<sup>(5)</sup> provide for the issuing of invitations to tender for export refunds; whereas it is convenient to repeal these invitations to tender;

Whereas the measures provided for in this Regulation are in accordance with the opinion of the Management Committee for Cereals,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

*Article 1*

Regulations (EEC) No 2471/88 and (EEC) No 2751/88 are hereby repealed as from 28 April 1989.

*Article 2*

This Regulation shall enter into force on the day following its publication in the *Official Journal of the European Communities*.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
