

COUNCIL REGULATION (EEC) No 3231/89

of 23 October 1989

on the application of Decision No 2/89 of the EEC—Switzerland Joint Committee altering the limits expressed in ecus in Article 8 of Protocol 3 concerning the definition of the concept of originating products and methods of administrative cooperation

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community, and in particular Article 113 thereof,

Article 1

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission,

Decision No 2/89 of the EEC—Switzerland Joint Committee shall apply in the Community.

Whereas the Agreement between the European Economic Community and the Swiss Confederation⁽¹⁾, signed on 22 July 1972 entered into force on 1 January 1973;

The text of the Decision is attached to this Regulation.

Whereas by virtue of Article 28 of Protocol 3 concerning the definition of the concept of originating products and methods of administrative cooperation, which forms an integral part of the said Agreement, the Joint Committee adopted Decision No 2/89 further amending Article 8 of that Protocol;

Article 2

Whereas it is necessary to apply that Decision in the Community,

This Regulation shall enter into force on the third day following its publication in the *Official Journal of the European Communities*.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
