

COMMISSION REGULATION (EEC) No 2408/90

of 14 August 1990

laying down a special rule concerning exports of certain beef sold under Regulation (EEC) No 1680/90

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 805/68 of 27 June 1968 on the common organization of the market in beef and veal⁽¹⁾, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 571/89⁽²⁾, and in particular Article 7 (3) thereof,Whereas Commission Regulation (EEC) No 1680/90⁽³⁾ on the sale by the procedure laid down in Regulation (EEC) No 2539/84 of boneless beef held by certain intervention agencies and intended for export provides for the sale of certain beef which is to be exported without refunds;

Whereas it should be specified that imports into the German Democratic Republic cannot be regarded as exports in this sense, given the provisions of Commission Regulation (EEC) No 2252/90 of 31 July 1990 laying down detailed rules for the application of Council Regulation (EEC) No 2060/90 on transitional measures concern-

ing trade with the German Democratic Republic in the agriculture and fisheries sector⁽⁴⁾;

Whereas the measures provided for in this Regulation are in accordance with the opinion of the Management Committee for Beef and Veal,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

In the case of the beef referred to in point (b) of Annex I to Regulation (EEC) No 1680/90, imports into the German Democratic Republic shall not be regarded as exports.

*Article 2*This Regulation shall enter into force on the day of its publication in the *Official Journal of the European Communities*.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
