

COMMISSION REGULATION (EEC) No 895/92
of 8 April 1992
fixing the import levies on rice and broken rice

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,
Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European
Economic Community,

Having regard to the Act of Accession of Spain and
Portugal,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 1418/76
of 21 June 1976 on the common organization of the
market in rice ⁽¹⁾, as last amended by Regulation (EEC)
No 674/92 ⁽²⁾, and in particular Article 11 (2) thereof,

Having regard to Commission Regulation (EEC)
No 883/87 of 23 March 1987 laying down detailed rules
for the application of Council Regulation (EEC)
No 3877/86 on imports rice of the long-grain aromatic
Basmati variety falling within CN codes 1006 10, 1006 20
and 1006 30 ⁽³⁾, as last amended by Regulation (EEC)
No 674/91 ⁽⁴⁾, and in particular Article 8 thereof,

Whereas the import levies on rice and broken rice were
fixed by Commission Regulation (EEC) No 586/92 ⁽⁵⁾, as
last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 789/92 ⁽⁶⁾,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

The import levies to be charged on the products listed in
Article 1 (1) (a) and (b) of Regulation (EEC) No 1418/76
shall be as set out in the Annex hereto.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on 9 April 1992.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member
States.
