

**COMMISSION REGULATION (EEC) No 1906/92**  
of 9 July 1992

**amending Regulation (EEC) No 1301/92 increasing to 1 000 000 tonnes the quantity of bread-making wheat held by the German intervention agency for which a standing invitation to tender for export has been opened**

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 2727/75 of 29 October 1975 on the common organization of the market in cereals<sup>(1)</sup>, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 1738/92<sup>(2)</sup>, and in particular Article 7 (6) thereof,

Having regard to Commission Regulation (EEC) No 1836/82 of 7 July 1982 laying down the procedure and conditions for the disposal of cereals held by the intervention agencies<sup>(3)</sup>, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 3043/91<sup>(4)</sup>,

Whereas Commission Regulation (EEC) No 1301/92<sup>(5)</sup>, as amended by Regulation (EEC) No 1585/92<sup>(6)</sup>, opened a standing invitation to tender for the export of 700 000 tonnes of bread-making wheat held by the German intervention agency; whereas, in a communication of 2 July 1992, Germany informed the Commission of the intention of its intervention agency to increase by 300 000 tonnes the quantity for which a standing invitation to tender for export has been opened; whereas the total quantity of bread-making wheat held by the German intervention agency for which a standing invitation to tender for export has been opened should be increased to 1 000 000 tonnes;

Whereas this increase in the quantity put out to tender makes it necessary to alter the list of regions and quantities in store; whereas Annex I to Regulation (EEC) No 1301/92 must therefore be amended;

Whereas the measures provided for in this Regulation are in accordance with the opinion of the Management Committee for Cereals,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

*Article 1*

Article 2 of Regulation (EEC) No 1301/92 is replaced by the following:

*Article 2*

1. The invitation to tender shall cover a maximum of 1 000 000 tonnes of bread-making quality to be exported to all third countries. Customs export formalities must be completed during the period 1 July to 31 August 1992.
2. The regions in which the 1 000 000 tonnes of common wheat of bread-making quality are stored are stated in Annex I to this Regulation.

*Article 2*

Annex I to Regulation (EEC) No 1301/92 is replaced by the Annex hereto.

*Article 3*

This Regulation shall enter into force on the day of its publication in the *Official Journal of the European Communities*.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
