

**COMMISSION REGULATION (EEC) No 3217/92**  
**of 4 November 1992**  
**fixing the aid for cotton**

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,  
Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

Having regard to the Act of Accession of Greece, and in particular paragraphs 3 and 10 of Protocol 4 thereto, as amended by the Act of Accession of Spain and Portugal, and in particular Protocol 14 annexed thereto, and Commission Regulation (EEC) No 4006/87<sup>(1)</sup>,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 2169/81 of 27 July 1981 laying down the general rules for the system of aid for cotton<sup>(2)</sup>, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 2053/92<sup>(3)</sup>, and in particular Article 5 (1) thereof,

Whereas the amount of the additional aid referred to in Article 5 (1) of Regulation (EEC) No 2169/81 was fixed by Commission Regulation (EEC) No 2539/92<sup>(4)</sup>, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 3175/92<sup>(5)</sup>;

Whereas it follows from applying the rules and other provisions contained in Regulation (EEC) No 2539/92 to the information at present available to the Commission that the amount of the aid at present in force should be altered as shown in Article 1 to this Regulation,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

*Article 1*

The aid for unginmed cotton referred to in Article 5 of Regulation (EEC) No 2169/81 shall be ECU 74,356 per 100 kilograms.

*Article 2*

This Regulation shall enter into force on 5 November 1992.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
