### **COMMISSION DECISION**

## of 1 July 1999

amending Decision 94/577/EC concerning animal health conditions and veterinary certifications for the importation of bovine semen from third countries

(notified under document number C(1999) 1775)

(Text with EEA relevance)

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Community,

Having regard to Council Directive 88/407/EEC of 14 June 1988 laying down the animal health requirements applicable to intra-Community trade in and imports of semen of domestic animals of the bovine speices (1), as last amended by Directive 93/60/EEC (2), and in particular Articles 10 and 11 thereof,

- Whereas Commission Decision 94/577/Ec (3) lays down the animal health conditions and veterinary certification for the importation of bovine semen from third coun-
- (2) Whereas Article 4(1) of Decision 88/407/EEC stipulates that as from 1 January 1999 trade in the semen of bulls giving a positive reaction to the serum neutralisation test or the Elisa test for infectious bovine rhinotracheitis/ infectious pustular vulov-vaginitis and not having been vaccinated in accordance with what Directive is banned;
- Whereas Article 10(4) of Decicion 88/407/EEC stipulates that the provisions applicable to intra-Community trade laid down in Article 4 of that Directive are to apply, mutatis mutandis to imports;
- Whereas the ceritificates laid down in Part 1 of Annexes A, B, C and D to Decision 94/577/EC should be

- amended so as to clarify the conditions applying to imports;
- Whereas the measures provided for in this Decision are in accordance with the opinion of the Standing Veterinary Committee,

HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION:

### Article 1

In Annexes A, B, C and D to Decision 94/577/CE, Part 1, point 13(d)(ii) is amended as follows:

- 1. At the end of the third indent 'or' is deleted,
- 2. The fourth indent is deleted.

### Article 2

This Decision is addressed to the Member States.
