

**COMMISSION REGULATION (EC) No 1465/1999****of 5 July 1999****amending Regulation (EC) No 1185/1999 increasing to 475 000 t the quantity of barley held by the Spanish intervention agency for which a standing invitation to tender for export has been opened**

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 1766/92 of 30 June 1992 on the common organisation of the market in cereals <sup>(1)</sup>, as last amended by Commission Regulation (EC) No 1253/1999 <sup>(2)</sup>, and in particular Article 5 thereof,

- (1) Whereas Commission Regulation (EEC) No 2131/93 <sup>(3)</sup>, as last amended by Regulation (EC) No 39/1999 <sup>(4)</sup>, lays down the procedures and conditions for the disposal of cereals held by the intervention agencies;
- (2) Whereas Commission Regulation (EC) No 1185/1999 <sup>(5)</sup>, opened a standing invitation to tender for the export of 375 000 t of barley held by the Spanish intervention agency; whereas, Spain informed the Commission of the intention of its intervention agency to increase by 100 000 t the quantity for which a standing invitation to tender for export has been opened; whereas the total quantity of barley held by the Spanish intervention agency for which a standing invitation to tender for export has been opened should be increased to 475 000 t;
- (3) Whereas this increase in the quantity put out to tender makes it necessary to alter the list of regions and quantities in store; whereas Annex I to Regulation (EC) No 1185/1999 must therefore be amended;

- (4) Whereas the measures provided for in this Regulation are in accordance with the opinion of the Management Committee for Cereals,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

*Article 1*

Regulation (EC) No 1185/1999 is hereby amended as follows:

1. Article 2 is replaced by the following:

*'Article 2*

1. The invitation to tender shall cover a maximum of 475 000 t of barley to be exported to all third countries, with the exception of the United States of America, Canada and Mexico.
2. The regions in which the 475 000 t of barley are stored are stated in Annex I to this Regulation.'

2. Annex I is replaced by the Annex hereto.

*Article 2*

This Regulation shall enter into force on the day of its publication in the *Official Journal of the European Communities*.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
