

**COMMISSION REGULATION (EC) No 1504/1999**  
**of 9 July 1999**  
**amending Regulation (EC) No 1304/1999 fixing export refunds on fruit and vegetables**

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EC) No 2200/96 of 28 October 1996 on the common organisation of the market in fruit and vegetables <sup>(1)</sup>, as last amended by Regulation (EC) No 857/1999 <sup>(2)</sup>, and in particular Article 35(11) thereof,

- (1) Whereas Commission Regulation (EC) No 2190/96 <sup>(3)</sup>, as last amended by Regulation (EC) No 1303/1999 <sup>(4)</sup>, lays down detailed rules for the application of export refunds on fruit and vegetables;
- (2) Whereas Commission Regulation (EC) No 1304/1999 <sup>(5)</sup>; as amended by Regulation (EC) No 1380/1999 <sup>(6)</sup>, sets the export refunds on fruit and vegetables;

- (3) Whereas there is currently an excess of peaches and nectarines on the market; whereas the refunds for those products should be increased so as to relieve the market;
- (4) Whereas the measures provided for in this Regulation are in accordance with the opinion of the Management Committee for Fruit and Vegetables,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

*Article 1*

In the Annex to Regulation (EC) No 1304/1999, in the line relating to peaches and nectarines, the scheduled quantity of 6 572 t for system B is replaced by 26 572 t.

*Article 2*

This Regulation shall enter into force on 10 July 1999.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
