COMMISSION REGULATION (EC) No 821/2000

of 19 April 2000

determining the extent to which the applications for import licences submitted in April 2000 for certain dairy products under certain tariff quotas opened by Regulation (EC) No 1374/98 can be accepted

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EC) No 1255/1999 of 17 May 1999 on the common organisation of the market in milk and milk products (1),

Having regard to Commission Regulation (EC) No 1374/98 of 29 June 1998 laying down detailed rules for the application of the import arrangements and opening tariff quotas for milk and milk products (2), as last amended by Regulation (EC) No 249/2000 (3), and in particular Article 14(4) thereof,

Whereas:

Applications lodged for the products referred to in Annex II to Regulation (EC) No 1374/98 concern quantities greater than those available; therefore, the allocation factors should be fixed for the quantities applied for,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

Import licences applied for for products falling within the order numbers in Annex II to Regulation (EC) No 1374/98 listed in the Annex lodged pursuant to Regulation (EC) No 1374/98 for the period 1 April to 30 June 2000, shall be awarded in accordance with the allocation factors indicated.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on 20 April 2000.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
