COMMISSION REGULATION (EC) No 324/2001

of 16 February 2001

opening a standing invitation to tender for the resale on the internal market of approximately 30 000 tonnes of rice held by the Spanish intervention agency

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EC) No 3072/95 of 22 December 1995 on the common organisation of the market in rice (1), as last amended by Regulation (EC) No 1667/2000 (2), and in particular the last indent of Article 8(b) thereof,

Whereas:

- Commission Regulation (EEC) No 75/91 (3) lays down (1)the procedures and conditions for the disposal of paddy rice held by intervention agencies.
- There is strong demand on the Community market at present for certain varieties of Japonica rice consumed on the internal market, with market prices higher than the intervention price. At the same time, certain quantities of rice of those varieties are available in the Spanish intervention agency's stores. Under those circumstances, a standing invitation to tender should be opened for the resale on the internal market of approximately 30 000 tonnes of Japonica paddy rice held by the Spanish intervention agency.
- The measures provided for in this Regulation are in (3) accordance with the opinion of the Management Committee for Cereals,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

The Spanish intervention agency shall open, under the conditions laid down in Regulation (EEC) No 75/91, a standing invitation to tender for the resale on the internal market of approximately 30 000 tonnes of Japonica paddy rice held by that agency, in accordance with Regulation (EEC) No 75/91.

Article 2

- The closing date for the submission of tenders in response to the first partial intivation to tender shall be 28 February 2001.
- The closing date for the submission of tenders in response to the last partial invitation to tender shall be 25 April 2001.
- Tenders must be lodged with the Spanish intervention agency at the following address:

Article 3

By Tuesday of the week following the closing date for the submission of tenders, the Spanish intervention agency shall notify the Commission of the quantities and the average prices of the various lots sold.

Article 4

This Regulation shall enter into force on the day following its publication in the Official Journal of the European Communities.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
