## COMMISSION REGULATION (EC) No 406/2002

of 1 March 2002

## deciding not to accept tenders submitted in response to the 284th partial invitation to tender as a general intervention measure pursuant to Regulation (EEC) No 1627/89

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EC) No 1254/1999 of 17 May 1999 on the common organisation of the market in beef and veal (1), as last amended by Commission Regulation (EC) No 2345/2001 (<sup>2</sup>), and in particular Article 47(8) thereof,

Whereas:

- Commission Regulation (EC) No 562/2000 of 15 March (1)2000 laying down detailed rules for the application of Council Regulation (EC) No 1254/1999 as regards the buying-in of beef (3), as last amended by Regulation (EC) No 1564/2001 (4), lays down buying standards. Pursuant to the abovementioned Regulation, an invitation to tender was opened pursuant to Article 1(1) of Commission Regulation (EEC) No 1627/89 of 9 June 1989 on the buying-in of beef by invitation to tender (5), as last amended by Regulation (EC) No 238/2002 (6).
- Article 13(1) of Regulation (EC) No 562/2000 lays (2)down that a maximum buying-in price is to be fixed for quality R3, where appropriate, under each partial invitation to tender in the light of tenders received. In accordance with Article 13(2) of that Regulation, a decision may be taken not to proceed with the tendering procedure.
- Once tenders submitted in respect of the 284th partial (3) invitation to tender have been considered and taking account, pursuant to Article 47(8) of Regulation (EC) No 1254/1999, of the requirements for reasonable support

of the market and the seasonal trend in slaughterings and prices, it has been decided not to proceed with the tendering procedure.

- Article 1(7) of Regulation (EC) No 1209/2001 of 20 (4) June 2001 derogating from Regulation (EC) No 562/ 2000 laying down detailed rules for the application of Council Regulation (EC) No 1254/1999 as regards as buying-in of beef (<sup>7</sup>), as last amended by Regulation (EC) No 2579/2001 (8), also opens buying-in of carcasses and half-carcasses of store cattle and lays down special rules in addition to those laid down for the buying-in of other products. For the 284th partial invitation to tender, no tender has been submitted.
- In the light of developments, this Regulation should (5) enter into force immediately.
- The measures provided for in this Regulation are in (6) accordance with the opinion of the Management Committee for Beef and Veal,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

## Article 1

No award shall be made against the 284th partial invitation to tender opened pursuant to Regulation (EEC) No 1627/89.

## Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on 2 March 2002.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
