

**COMMISSION REGULATION (EC) No 30/2003****of 8 January 2003****concerning Regulation (EC) No 2375/2002 opening and providing for the administration of Community tariff quotas for common wheat of a quality other than high quality imported from third countries and derogating from Council Regulation (EEC) No 1766/92**

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 1766/92 of 30 June 1992 on the common organisation of the market in cereals<sup>(1)</sup>, as last amended by Regulation (EC) No 1666/2000<sup>(2)</sup>, and in particular Article 12(1) thereof,

Whereas:

- (1) Commission Regulation (EC) No 2375/2002<sup>(3)</sup> provides, in particular, for preferential access for 592 900 tonnes of common wheat originating in other third countries during the period from 1 January to 31 March 2003.
- (2) The Commission is required to fix a single reduction coefficient to be applied to quantities covered by import licence applications in excess of the quarterly quota. Import licence applications lodged on 3 and 6 January 2003 for common wheat from other third countries

may cover 16 357 452 tonnes and the maximum quantity which may be imported at a duty of EUR 12 per tonne is 592 900 tonnes,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

*Article 1*

Applications for import licences for Subquota III — Tranche No 1/2003 of the quota for common wheat provided for in Regulation (EC) No 2375/2002 at an import duty of EUR 12 per tonne for common wheat of a quality other than high quality falling within CN code 1001 90 99 lodged on 3 and 6 January 2003 and notified to the Commission shall be accepted for the quantities shown therein reduced by a coefficient of 0,03625.

*Article 2*

This Regulation shall enter into force on 9 January 2003.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
