

COMMISSION REGULATION (EC) No 149/2004
of 28 January 2004
laying down special measures concerning the application of Regulation (EC) No 2246/2003 in the
pigmeat sector

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Community,

Having regard to Commission Regulation (EEC) No 3444/90 of 27 November 1990 laying down detailed rules for granting private storage aid for pigmeat ⁽¹⁾, as last amended by Regulation (EC) No 851/2003 ⁽²⁾, and in particular Article 11(b) thereof,

Whereas:

An examination of the situation has indicated a risk that there will be an excessively large number of applications for the private storage aid scheme introduced by Commission Regulation (EC) No 2246/2003 ⁽³⁾. Therefore, it is necessary to suspend application of the Regulation and reject the applications in question,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

1. Application of Regulation (EC) No 2246/2003 is hereby suspended for the period 30 January to 5 February 2004.
2. Applications submitted from 23 to 29 January 2004 for which acceptance decisions would have had to be taken during that period, are hereby rejected.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on 29 January 2004.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
