

**COUNCIL JOINT ACTION 2005/143/CFSP**  
**of 17 February 2005**  
**amending Joint Action 2002/210/CFSP on the European Union Police Mission**

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN UNION,

HAS ADOPTED THIS JOINT ACTION:

Having regard to the Treaty on European Union and, in particular, Articles 14 and 25(3) thereof,

*Article 1*

The following paragraph shall be added to Article 8 of Joint Action 2002/210/CFSP:

Whereas:

‘4. The Political and Security Committee shall take the relevant decisions on the setting-up of a Committee of Contributors.’

- (1) On 11 March 2002 the Council adopted Joint Action 2002/210/CFSP<sup>(1)</sup> establishing a European Union Police Mission (EUPM) in order to ensure the follow-on to the United Nations International Police Task Force in Bosnia and Herzegovina as from 1 January 2003.

*Article 2*

This Joint Action shall enter into force on the date of its adoption.

- (2) The Political and Security Committee should be authorised to take the relevant decisions on the setting-up of a Committee of Contributors for the EUPM, in line with the document on ‘Consultations and Modalities for the Contribution of non-EU States to EU Civilian Crisis Management’ approved by the Council on 10 December 2002.

*Article 3*

This Joint Action shall be published in the *Official Journal of the European Union*.

- (3) Joint Action 2002/210/CFSP should be amended accordingly,
