COMMISSION REGULATION (EC) No 1842/2005

of 10 November 2005

concerning tenders notified in response to the invitation to tender for the import of maize issued in Regulation (EC) No 1808/2005

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EC) No 1784/2003 of 29 September 2003 on the common organisation of the market in cereals (1), and in particular Article 12(1) thereof,

Whereas:

- An invitation to tender for the maximum reduction in (1)the duty on maize imported into Spain from third countries was opened pursuant to Commission Regulation (EC) No 1808/2005 (2).
- (2)Article 7 of Commission Regulation (EC) No 1839/95 (3), allows the Commission to decide, in accordance with the procedure laid down in Article 25 of Regulation (EC) No 1784/2003 and on the basis of the tenders notified, to make no award.

- On the basis of the criteria laid down in Articles 6 and 7 (3) of Regulation (EC) No 1839/95 a maximum reduction in the duty should not be fixed.
- The measures provided for in this Regulation are in accordance with the opinion of the Management Committee for Cereals,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

No action shall be taken on the tenders notified from 4 to 10 November 2005 in response to the invitation to tender for the reduction in the duty on imported maize issued in Regulation (EC) No 1808/2005.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on 11 November 2005.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
