

**POLITICAL AND SECURITY COMMITTEE DECISION (CFSP) 2015/2201****of 13 November 2015****on the acceptance of third States' contributions to the European Union Advisory Mission for Civilian Security Sector Reform Ukraine (EUAM Ukraine) (EUAM Ukraine/5/2015)**

THE POLITICAL AND SECURITY COMMITTEE,

Having regard to the Treaty on European Union, and in particular the third paragraph of Article 38 thereof,

Having regard to Council Decision 2014/486/CFSP of 22 July 2014 on the European Union Advisory Mission for Civilian Security Sector Reform Ukraine (EUAM Ukraine) <sup>(1)</sup>,

Whereas:

- (1) Pursuant to Article 10(3) of Decision 2014/486/CFSP, the Council authorised the Political and Security Committee ('PSC') to take the relevant decisions on the acceptance of proposed contributions to EUAM Ukraine by third States.
- (2) The Civilian Operation Commander recommended that the PSC accept the proposed contributions from Georgia to EUAM Ukraine and to consider the contribution as significant.
- (3) Georgia should be exempted from financial contributions to the budget of EUAM Ukraine,

HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION:

*Article 1***Third States' contributions**

1. The contribution from Georgia to EUAM Ukraine is accepted and considered to be significant.
2. Georgia is exempted from financial contributions to the budget of EUAM Ukraine.

*Article 2***Entry into force**

This Decision shall enter into force on the date of its adoption.
