PROPOSAL FOR A COUNCIL DECISION AMENDING
THE STATUTES OF THE EURATOM SUPPLY AGENCY FOLLOWING THE
ACCESSION OF NEW MEMBER STATES TO THE COMMUNITY

The Council of the European Communities,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Atomic Energy Community, and notably Article 5.4 (2) and (3),

Having regard to Article 153 (2) of the Act of Accession Treaty for the new member countries,

Having regard to the proposal of the Commission,

RESOLVES :

Article 1

The provisions of Article V (1) and (2) of the statutes of the Euratom Supply Agency¹ shall be amended as follows :

- 1) The capital of the Agency shall amount to 3 200 000 EPU units of account.
- 2) The capital shall be distributed as follows :

Belgium	:	6%
Germany	:	21%
Denmark	:	3%
France	:	21%
Ireland	:	1%
Italy	:	21%
Netherlands	:	6%
United Kingdom	:	21%

Article 2

The provisions of Article X (1) and (2) of the said statutes are amended as follows :

- 1) An advisory committee for the Agency shall be set up comprising 33 members.

2) The seats shall be divided between nationals of the Member States as follows :

Belgium	:	3 members
Germany	:	6 members
Denmark	:	2 members
France	:	6 members
Ireland	:	1 member
Italy	:	6 members
Netherlands	:	3 members
United Kingdom	:	6 members
