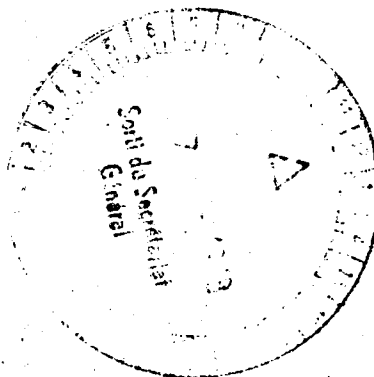

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) N° 805/68 of 27 June 1968 on the
common organisation of the market in beef and veal ¹, as last amended by
Regulation (EEC) N° 425/77 ², and in particular Article 13 thereof,

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission,

HAS ADOPTED THIS ESTIMATE :

Introduction

This estimate covers the period 1 January to 31 December 1979.

It has been drawn up in the light of the information available to the
Commission and in accordance with current forecasts. It is based on the
numbers of young male bovine animals intended for fattening which the
Community has imported from non-member countries in previous years, in
particular in 1978, and on the estimated availabilities and requirements
in 1979 of young male bovine animals intended for fattening in the
Community.

1. Imports from non-member countries in previous years.

In previous years around 200 000 young male bovine animals intended for fattening have been imported into the Community; it is estimated that in 1978 imports of these animals will be slightly above this level.

2. Factors affecting 1979

- a) At the end of 1978 it is expected that the number of young male bovine animals (bovine animals of less than 1 year) will fall by about 150 000, including 80 000 fewer males.
- b) The foreseeable fall in the number of cows and heifers at the end of 1978 (around 150 000 head) will result in fewer calves being born in 1979; the number of available calves should be around 120 000 less so that during the year production of male calves should fall by about 60 000 head.
- c) As a result of a) and b), entries should fall by 140 000 head.
- d) Finally, it is expected that slaughterings will drop by around 130 000 head. Thus, due to reduced slaughterings, the production of male calves in 1979 should be around 60 000 head less than in 1978.
- e) Thus in 1979 availabilities of bovine animals of Community origin will be about 80 000 head less than in 1978.

3. On the basis of information supplied by Member States, reviewed in the light of the most recent statistical information on livestock numbers and trade, the Community will need to import at least 250 000 young animals for fattening in 1979.

Conclusion

On the basis of the above considerations the estimate of young male bovine animals intended for fattening which may be imported in 1979 under Article 13 of Regulation (EEC) No 805/68 shall be fixed at 250 000 head.
