extending the provisional anti dumping duty on imports
of bicycles originating in the People's Republic of China

(presented by the Commission)

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

1. Commission Regulation (EEC) No 550/93 imposed a provisional anti-dumping duty on imports of bicycles originating in People's Republic of China.
2. Examination of the facts has not yet been completed.
3. The Commission has informed the exporters known to be concerned of its intention to extend the validity of the provisional duty for an additional period of two months. The exporters have raised no objection.
4. Accordingly, pursuant to Article 11(5) of Council Regulation No 2423/88, the Commission is submitting to the Council a draft Regulation extending the validity of the provisional anti-dumping duty on imports of bicycles originating in People's Republic of China for an additional period of two months.

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 2423/88 of 11 July 1988 on protection against dumped or subsidized imports from countries not members of the European Economic Community⁽¹⁾, and in particular Article 11 thereof,

Having regard to the Commission proposal,

Whereas Commission Regulation (EEC) No 550/93⁽²⁾ imposed a provisional anti-dumping duty on imports of bicycles originating in the People's Republic of China;

Whereas examination of the facts has not yet been completed and the Commission has informed the exporters known to be concerned of its intention to propose an extension of the validity of the provisional duty for an additional period of two months;

Whereas the exporters have raised no objection,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION :

Article 1

The validity of the provisional anti-dumping duty on imports of bicycles originating in the People's Republic of China imposed by Regulation (EEC) No 550/93 is hereby extended for a period of two months. It shall cease to apply if, before the expiry of that period, the Council adopts definitive measures or the proceeding is terminated under Article 9 of Regulation (EEC) No 2423/88.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on the day following its publication in the Official Journal of the European Communities.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
