

Proposal for a Council Regulation amending Regulation (EEC) No 3013/89 on the common organization of the market in sheepmeat and goatmeat and Regulation (EEC) No 3493/90 establishing the general rules for the granting of the premium to sheepmeat and goatmeat producers

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community, and in particular Article 43 thereof,

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission,

Having regard to the opinion of the European Parliament,

Having regard to the opinion of the Economic and Social Committee,

Whereas experience indicates that Regulation (EEC) No 3013/89 (*) requires certain simplification and amendment;

Whereas the introduction of an individual premium limit per producer has limited the number of ewes and female goats eligible for the premium;

Whereas this measure obviates the need for the headage limits for determining the level of premium payment in the sector without modifying the entitlement to premiums already granted to producers; whereas, therefore, provision should be made for the establishment of corrected individual limits;

Whereas this modification entrains further modifications in Regulation (EEC) No 3493/90 establishing the general rules for the granting of the premium to sheepmeat and goatmeat producers (?),

Article 1

Regulation (EEC) No 3013/89 is hereby amended as follows:

1. Paragraph 7 of Article 5 is deleted.
2. The following paragraph is added to Article 5a:

'6. Member States shall recalculate the individual limits in such a way that the quantities above 500/1 000 limits referred to in the former Article 5 (7) are reduced by 50 %.'

Article 2

Article 2 (1) of Regulation (EEC) No 3493/90 is deleted.

Article 3

This Regulation shall enter into force on the seventh day following its publication in the *Official Journal of the European Communities*.

It shall apply with effect from the 1994 marketing year.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
