### Amended proposal for a

#### **COUNCIL DIRECTIVE**

amending Directive 91/439/EEC on driving licences

(presented by the Commission pursuant to Article 189 a (2) of the EC-Treaty)



#### **EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM**

A. On 20 February 1996 the Commission submitted to the Council a proposal for a Directive amending Directive 91/439/EEC on driving licences (COM(96) 55 final - SYN 96/0040 1).

On 24 April 1996 <sup>2</sup> the Economic and Social Committee gave a favourable opinion.

On 5 September 1996 the European Parliament gave an opinion on the proposal at the first reading. The Commission accepts amendment 1 and takes account, in the amended proposal in the annex, of amendment 5, although it is unable to accept it in full.

The Commission has not been able to accept the other amendments tabled by Parliament for the following reasons:

- the recital concerning the code of conduct does not relate to any of the articles;
- the recital on setting up a European penalty points driving licence system and that on mutual recognition of decisions to suspend or withdraw driving licences fall outside the proposal remit;
- introducing a universal code 00, without a definition, would run counter to the proposal's objective which is to define harmonized codes which everyone can easily understand;
- the obligation to subdivide codes before 31 December 1996 does not correspond to the content of Article 2 of the Commission proposal. According to this provision the task of subdividing codes actually falls on the appropriate committee, which must take scientific and technical progress into consideration; this also applies after 31.12.1996;
- the amendment concerning the committee's composition and working methods is not in line with the provisions of Council Decision 87/373/EEC on committee procedure;
- the amendment on mutual recognition of decisions to suspend or withdraw driving licences falls outside the proposal remit;
- the amendment on medical standards for driving falls outside the proposal remit.
