**Legislative resolution of the European Parliament on current legislative procedures pending as at 1 May 1999 in the area of industry, external trade, research and energy (Commission communication to the European Parliament and the Council – Effects of the entry into force of the Amsterdam Treaty (SEC(1999) 581 – C4-0219/1999))**

(Codecision procedure: confirmation of first reading)

*The European Parliament,*

- having regard to the list of Commission proposals pending as at 1 May 1999 for which the entry into force of the Amsterdam Treaty involves a change in legal basis and/or procedure (SEC(1999) 581 – C4-0219/1999),
- having regard to its resolution of 4 May 1999<sup>(1)</sup> on the implications of the entry into force of the Amsterdam Treaty (list of legislative proposals pending before the Council as at 1 May 1999, indicating new legal bases and any changes in legislative procedure following the entry into force of the Treaty of Amsterdam) (C4-0134/1999 – SEC(1999) 581 – C4-0219/1999),
- having regard to Article 251(2) of the EC Treaty,
- having regard to the report of the Committee on Industry, External Trade, Research and Energy (A5-0008/1999/rev.),

1. Confirms, as its first reading under the codecision procedure, the text adopted on 12 November 1996<sup>(2)</sup> on the proposal for a Council Directive to introduce rational planning techniques in the electricity and gas distribution sectors (COM(1995) 369 – C4-0030/1996 – 1995/0208(COD) – formerly 1995/0208(SYN));

2. Instructs its President to forward this legislative resolution to the Council and Commission.
