The European Parliament,

- having regard to the Commission proposal (COM(2000) 786) (1),
- having regard to Article 34(2) (c) of the EU Treaty,
- having been consulted by the Council pursuant to Article 39 of the EU Treaty (C5-0753/2000),
- having regard to Rules 106 and 67 of its Rules of Procedure,
- having regard to the report of the Committee on Citizens' Freedoms and Rights, Justice and Home Affairs (A5-0094/2001),
- 1. Approves the Commission proposal as amended;
- 2. Calls on the Council to notify Parliament should it intend to depart from the text approved by Parliament;
- 3. Asks to be consulted again if the Council intends to amend the Commission proposal substantially;
- 4. Instructs its President to forward its position to the Council and Commission.

Amendment 1

Recital 1

- (1) The Union has set itself the objective of maintaining and developing the Union as an area of freedom, security and justice, in which the free movement of persons is assured.

Amendment 2 Recital 9

- (9) In accordance with the principles of subsidiarity and proportionality as set out in Article 5 of the Treaty, the objectives of this Decision to improve effective judicial cooperation between the Member States and effective access to justice for persons engag-
- (9) The **objective** of this Decision **is to ensure effective** access to justice and speedy and reliable procedures for persons engaging in cross-border litigation by improving effective judicial cooperation between the Member States. In
