Prior notification of a concentration

(Case COMP/M.2701 — Vattenfall/Bewag)

(Text with EEA relevance)

- On 3 January 2002 the Commission received notification of a proposed concentration pursuant to Article 4 of Council Regulation (EEC) No 4064/89 (1), as last amended by Regulation (EC) No 1310/97 (2), by which the Swedish undertaking Vattenfall AB (Vattenfall) acquires, within the meaning of Article 3(1)(b) of the Regulation, control of the whole of the German undertaking Berliner Kraft- und Licht Aktiengesellschaft (Bewag) by way of purchase of shares.
- The business activities of the undertakings concerned are:
- Vattenfall: generation, transport and supply of electricity mainly in the Nordic countries and Germany; generation of heat; trading activities in electricity, natural gas and heat,
- Bewag: generation, transport and supply of electricity in Germany, generation of district heat; trading activities in electricity.
- On preliminary examination, the Commission finds that the notified concentration could fall within the scope of Regulation (EEC) No 4064/89. However, the final decision on this point is reserved.
- The Commission invites interested third parties to submit their possible observations on the proposed operation.
