The European Parliament,

- having regard to the Council common position (13241/1/2006 C6-0420/2006),
- having regard to its position at first reading (¹) on the Commission proposal to Parliament and the Council (COM(2005)0115) (²),
- having regard to the amended Commission proposal (COM(2006)0235) (3),
- having regard to Article 251(2) of the EC Treaty,
- having regard to Rule 67 of its Rules of Procedure,
- having regard to the recommendation for second reading of the Committee on the Internal Market and Consumer Protection (A6-0408/2006);
- 1. Approves the common position;
- 2. Notes that the act is adopted in accordance with the common position;
- 3. Instructs its President to sign the act with the President of the Council pursuant to Article 254(1) of the EC Treaty;
- 4. Instructs its Secretary-General to sign the act, once it has been verified that all the procedures have been duly completed, and, in agreement with the Secretary-General of the Council, to have it published in the Official Journal of the European Union;
