

Explanatory notes to the Combined Nomenclature of the European Union

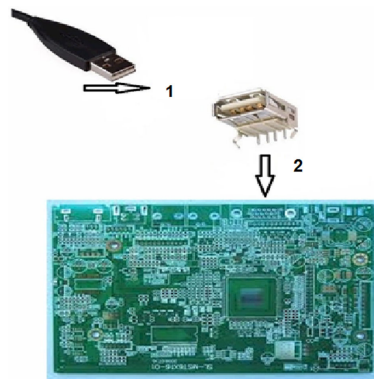
Pursuant to the second indent of Article 9(1)(a) of Council Regulation (EEC) No 2658/87 ⁽¹⁾, the explanatory notes to the Combined Nomenclature of the European Union ⁽²⁾ are hereby amended as follows:

On page 345:

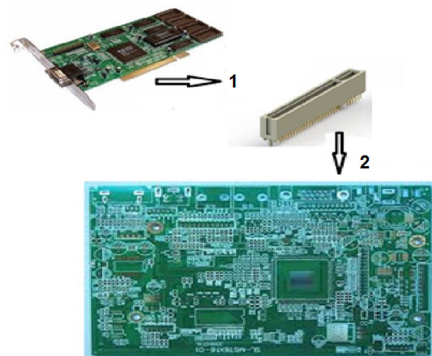
8536 69 30 For printed circuits

The existing text and figures are replaced by the following:

This subheading covers plugs and sockets that are intended to be directly attached to a printed circuit board (PCB) or flexible printed circuit on at least one side of the plug or socket (see the examples below).



- 1: This USB connector is not intended to be directly attached to a PCB and is therefore excluded from this subheading.
- 2: This USB receptacle is intended to be directly attached to a PCB and is therefore included within this subheading.



- 1: This connector is not intended to be directly attached to a PCB and is therefore excluded from this subheading.
- 2: This connector is intended to be directly attached to a PCB and is therefore included within this subheading.

On page 346:

The explanatory note to CN code 8536 69 90 is deleted.
