Summary of the Judgment

Member States — Obligations — Failure to fulfil obligations — Failure to fulfil specific obligations under a directive and failure to fulfil the general obligation imposed by Article 5 of the Treaty

(EEC Treaty, Arts 5 and 169)

Where a Member State has failed to fulfil the specific obligations imposed by a directive, there is no need to examine whether it has

thereby also failed to fulfil its obligations under Article 5 of the Treaty.
