# Judgment of the Court (Seventh Chamber) of 1 April 2008 — Commission v Luxembourg

(Case C-417/07)

(Failure of a Member State to fulfil obligations — Directive 2004/36/EC —
Safety of third-country aircraft using Community airports —
Failure to transpose within the prescribed period)

- 1. Actions for failure to fulfil obligations Right of the Commission to bring judicial proceedings To be exercised at its discretion (Art. 226 EC) (see para. 7)
- 2. Acts of the institutions Directives Implementation by Member States Need for clear and precise transposition (Art. 249 EC) (see para. 10)

Failure of a Member State to fulfil obligations — Failure to adopt, within the prescribed period, the measures necessary to comply with Directive 2004/36/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 21 April 2004 on the safety of third-country aircraft using Community airports (OJ 2004 L 143, p. 76).

### **Operative part**

#### The Court:

- 1. Declares that by failing to adopt, within the prescribed period, the laws, regulations and administrative provisions necessary to comply with Directive 2004/36/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 21 April 2004 on the safety of third-country aircraft using Community airports, the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg has failed to fulfil its obligations under that directive:
- 2. Orders the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg to pay the costs.

## Judgment of the Court (Fifth Chamber) of 3 April 2008 — Commission v Belgium

(Failure of a Member State to fulfil obligations — Regulation (EC)
No 2037/2000 — Substances that deplete the ozone layer — Recovery, recycling, reclamation and destruction of those substances)

Actions for failure to fulfil obligations — Examination of merits by the Court — Situation to be taken into consideration — Situation on expiry of the period laid down in the reasoned opinion (Art. 226 EC) (see para. 19)
