

In the absence of any information to the effect that the Republic of Malta has decommissioned non-critical uses of halons in fire protection systems and fire extinguishers on all the ships listed in the form attached to its reply to the letter of formal notice and has recovered these halons, the Commission concludes that the Republic of Malta has failed to fulfil its obligations under Articles 4(4)(v) and 16 of the regulation.
