Summary of the Judgment

International agreements — EC-Switzerland Agreement on the free movement of persons — Access to self-employed activity and the exercise thereof

(EC-Switzerland Agreement on the free movement of persons, Annex I, Arts 13 and 15(1))

Pursuant to Article 15(1) of Annex I to the Agreement between the European Community and its Member States, of the one part, and the Swiss Confederation, of the other, on the free movement of persons, a contracting party must accord to the 'self-employed frontier workers', within the meaning of Article 13 of that annex, of the other contracting party no less favourable

treatment as regards access to self-employed activity and the pursuit thereof in the host State than that which is accorded by that State to its own nationals.
