

**Judgment of the General Court (Eighth Chamber) of 12 November 2010 —
Deutsche Bahn v OHIM
(Horizontal combination of the colours grey and red)**

(Case T-404/09)

(Community trade mark — Application for Community trade mark consisting in a horizontal combination of the colours grey and red — Absolute ground for refusal — Lack of distinctive character — Article 7(1)(b) of Regulation (EC) No 207/2009)

Community trade mark — Definition and acquisition of the Community trade mark — Absolute grounds for refusal — Marks devoid of any distinctive character (Council Regulation No 207/2009, Art. 7(1)(b)) (see paras 26, 28-37)
