- 8. The Commission expects that the envisaged agreement will have a positive dynamic economic effect on both South Africa and the other countries in the region.
- 9. Ad referendum agreement has been reached on the main principles and the bulk of the measures and draft articles of the envisaged agreement.
- 10. Ad referendum agreement has not yet been reached on some measures, the trade section and the product lists annexed to the agreement, due to a remaining gap between offers and requests of both sides.
- 11. Ad referendum agreement has been reached on a general safeguard, an agricultural safeguard and a regional (South African customs union) safeguard clause which would allow South Africa exceptionally to take measures to redress disturbances to domestic market caused by imports of products originating in the Community.
- 12. The general safeguard, the agricultural safeguard and another regional (Réunion) safeguard can be equally applied by the Community, in cases where imports originating in South Africa would cause serious disturbance to the Community market.
