#### Prior notification of a concentration

(Case No IV/M.518 — Winterthur/Schweizer Rück)

(95/C 44/03)

(Text with EEA relevance)

1. On 13 February 1995, the Commission received a notification of a proposed concentration pursuant to Article 4 of Council Regulation (EEC) No 4064/89 (\*) by which 'Winterthur' Schweizerische Versicherungs-Gesellschaft acquires within the meaning of Article 3 (1) (b) of the Council Regulation control of Schweiz Assicurazione SpA, Schweiz Vita SpA, Schweiz Compañía Anónima Española de Seguros y Reaseguros and La Equitativa, SA by way of purchase of shares from Schweizerische Rückversicherungs-Gesellschaft.

2. The business sector concerned is insurance, mainly in Italy, Spain and Portugal.

3. Upon preliminary examination, the Commission finds that the notified concentration could fall within the scope of Regulation (EEC) No 4064/89. However, the final decision on this point is reserved.

4. The Commission invites interested third parties to submit their possible observations on the proposed operation to the Commission.
