2. **Description of services:** the principal function will be to collect information concerning the consumption of tobacco, and public health aspects of tobacco smoking; economic, statistical, legislative and political aspects of the production, processing, sale and consumption of tobacco and tobacco products in the European Union; and to make proposals to the Commission on the ways and means of increasing public awareness of the risks of tobacco smoking and the organization of public information campaigns.

3. **Place of delivery:** Luxembourg.

4. a) **Who may submit tenders:** tenders may be submitted by any legal or natural person established in the European Union, or by groups or associations of such persons.

b) **Law, regulation or administrative provision:** Belgian law.

c) **Names and qualifications of staff:** indicate as appropriate.

5. **Division into lots:** only tenders for the complete task will be considered.

6. **Duration of contract or time limit for completion of the service:** the estimated contract length is about 1 year, renewable for the length of the 3rd action plan.

9. **Deposits or guarantees required:** applicable if first payment is higher than 100 000 ECU.

10. **Main terms concerning financing and payments and/or references to the relevant provisions:** the budget for these contracts will be paid as follows, subject to modification in the light of the contract length:

— 30 % on signature of the contract and quarterly payment of invoices (after deduction of the advance).

11. **Information concerning the service provider's own position:** the minimum professional qualifications and experience required are set out in the tender documents.

12. **Period during which the tenderer is bound to keep open his tender:** 12 months after the deadline for receipt of submission.

13. **Selection criteria:**

All interested tenderers must offer proof:

1. of sufficient financial, economic and professional means to allow them to complete the tasks which are the subject of this call to tender. This may be given by means of:

— bank declarations, balance sheets or extracts of balance sheets, turnover figures for the past 3 years,

— or attestations or extracts of the record from the Register of Companies, VAT or Social Security.

2. of their technical ability, which will allow them to complete the tasks described. This may be given of means of:

— an indication of the academic or professional qualifications of the tenderer, and/or the management of the tendering firm,

particularly those concerned with the tender, together with a detailed list of their publications including those of the proposed experts in the fields described.

- a description of the measures taken by the tenderer to ensure the quality of the service and the resources of the company, especially with regard to its capacity to undertake the tasks described at a Community level, taking into account the linguistic situation in the Community.

14. *Criteria for awarding the contract*

The contract will be awarded to the tenderer making the most economically advantageous offer, based on:

- price;

- the quality of the work offered, i.e. the competence of the tenderer in the area of collection, analysis, interpretation and presentation of data concerning tobacco and those aspects of public health linked to tobacco, as well as the other areas involved in this call for tender, concerning the economic, statistical, legislative and political aspects of production, processing, sale and consumption of tobacco and tobacco products at a national level in the Member States and at a Community and international level, and the competence of the tenderer in the field of increasing public awareness of the risks of tobacco smoking and information campaigns.
