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| <p>1. <b>Awarding authority:</b> European Commission, Directorate-General for Environment, Nuclear Safety and Civil Protection (DG XI), Unit E.3 - Waste Management Policy, rue de la Loi/Wetstraat 200, B-1049 Bruxelles/Brussel.</p> <p>2. <b>Award procedure:</b> Open invitation to tender XI.E.3/96/0015.</p> <p>3. <b>Reason for invitation to tender:</b> This invitation to tender aims, on the one hand, to compensate for the shortage of up-to-date information in the field of waste generation and waste management and, on the other hand, to deal with the problem concerning the comparability of data due to divergent classifications, definitions and methodologies applied in the 15 Member States.</p> <p>4. <b>Contents:</b> DG XI plans to award a study contract in the field of wastage statistics. The study will comprise 2 parts.</p> <p style="padding-left: 20px;"><i>Part 1:</i> Bringing to light current trends in the fields of waste generation and waste management for the 15 Member States.</p> <p style="padding-left: 20px;">The aim of the first part is to bring to the fore trends in the field of waste generation and waste management, over the past 5 years and covering the 15 Member States. This work will be based on existing quantitative data.</p> | <p><i>Part 2:</i> Feasibility study for the development of a methodology for the establishment of a European system for the collection of data on the generation and management of waste.</p> <p>This second part consists of the development of a methodology for the collection of data on the generation and management of waste. The basic element will be the elaboration of a matrix to describe the phenomenon of waste, via an aggregation of codes, with each one providing essential and unique data. The evaluation of the possibility of applying the developed methodology to the 15 Member States, while defining the appropriate sample for each one, will be a crucial stage of this work.</p> <p>5. <b>Contract duration:</b> The entire study must be completed within 12 months from the date of signature of the contract.</p> <p>6. <b>Requests for documents:</b></p> <p>a) By letter or facsimile to the address in 1, for the attention of Mr Sinnott, DG XI.A.2, 'Budget, Finance and Contracts' Unit, facsimile (02) 299 44 49.</p> |
