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2. Category of service and description: Licensing has been as a key aspect of the future regulatory framework for telecommunications in an open environment. On 14.11.1995 the Commission adopted a proposal for a directive on a common framework for general authorizations and individual licences in the field of telecommunications services (COM (95) 545).

Access to scarce resources (radiofrequencies, public and private land, numbers, etc.) is an important issue with regard to the possibilities offered to new players to actually enter telecommunications markets. At the same time, the current regulatory situation in Member States with regard to management and allocation of resources like radiofrequencies and numbers, as well as with regard to access to public and private land, appears relatively unclear.

The purpose of the study is to provide the Commission with an overiew of Member States' licensing regimes in relation to scarce resources.
