

**Commission notice updating the list of parties under examination pursuant to Regulation (EC)  
No 88/97**

(97/C 378/02)

Annex I to Commission Regulation (EC) No 88/97 of 20 January 1997 authorizing the exemption of imports of certain bicycle parts originating in the People's Republic of China from the extension imposed by Council Regulation 71/97 of the anti-dumping duty imposed by Regulation (EEC) No 2474/93<sup>(1)</sup>, comprises a list of parties whose requests for authorization for exemption from the extended anti-dumping duty imposed by Regulation (EC) No 71/97<sup>(2)</sup> are under examination.
