

Withdrawal of notification of a concentration**(Case COMP/M.1991 — Trelleborg/Icopal)**

On 29 May 2000 the Commission received notification of a proposed concentration between Trelleborg and Icopal. On 16 June 2000 the notifying parties informed the Commission that they withdrew their notification because Trelleborg's public offer for Icopal had not achieved a shareholding sufficient to confer control.
