

Commission notification on the issuing of licences to railway undertakings

(2000/C 380/06)

Under Article 11(8) of Council Directive 95/18/EC of 19 June 1995 on the licensing of railway undertakings the Commission is obliged to inform the Member States of the situation regarding licences. The main aspects of the licence issued by the office in point 2 are set out below.

The licence holder is required to inform the Directorate-General of the Ground Transport Administration within the Ministry of Communications and Infrastructure of any change in the situation which could affect compliance with the conditions under which the licence was issued

6. Observations regarding suspensions, revocations or amendments:

The licence is re-examined every five years by the Director-General of the abovementioned administration. The holder shall submit the licence to the above at the latest three months after that deadline with a view to a complete re-examination of the conditions of issue.

The Director-General of the abovementioned administration may check at any time whether the conditions of issue are being met. He will suspend or withdraw the licence that he has delivered if the holder thereof does not meet the conditions laid down
