## Prior notification of a concentration

## (Case COMP/M.4059 — Swiss Re/GE Insurance Solutions)

## (Text with EEA relevance)

- 1. On 15 March 2006, the Commission received a notification of a proposed concentration pursuant to Article 4 of Council Regulation (EC) No 139/2004 (¹) by which the undertaking Swiss Reinsurance Company ('Swiss Re', Switzerland) acquires within the meaning of Article 3(1)(b) of the Council Regulation control of a substantial part of the direct insurance and reinsurance businesses of General Electric Company ('GE IS', USA) by way of purchase of shares and assets.
- 2. The business activities of the undertakings concerned are:
- for Swiss Re: the worldwide supply of traditional reinsurance services, both life and non-life, as well as direct life and non-life insurance services;
- for GE IS: the worldwide supply of traditional reinsurance services, both life and non-life, as well as direct non-life insurance services.
- 3. On preliminary examination, the Commission finds that the notified transaction could fall within the scope of Regulation (EC) No 139/2004. However, the final decision on this point is reserved.
- 4. The Commission invites interested third parties to submit their possible observations on the proposed operation to the Commission.
